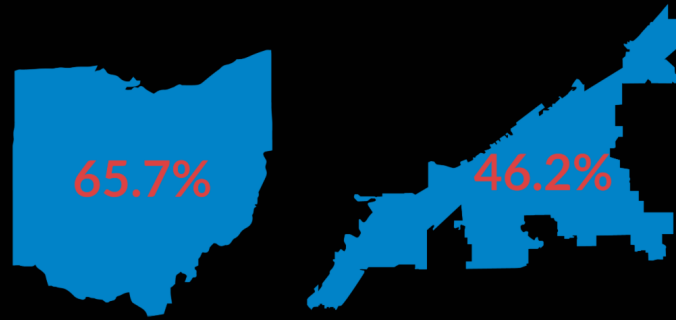

RACE BY %

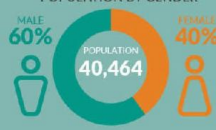
