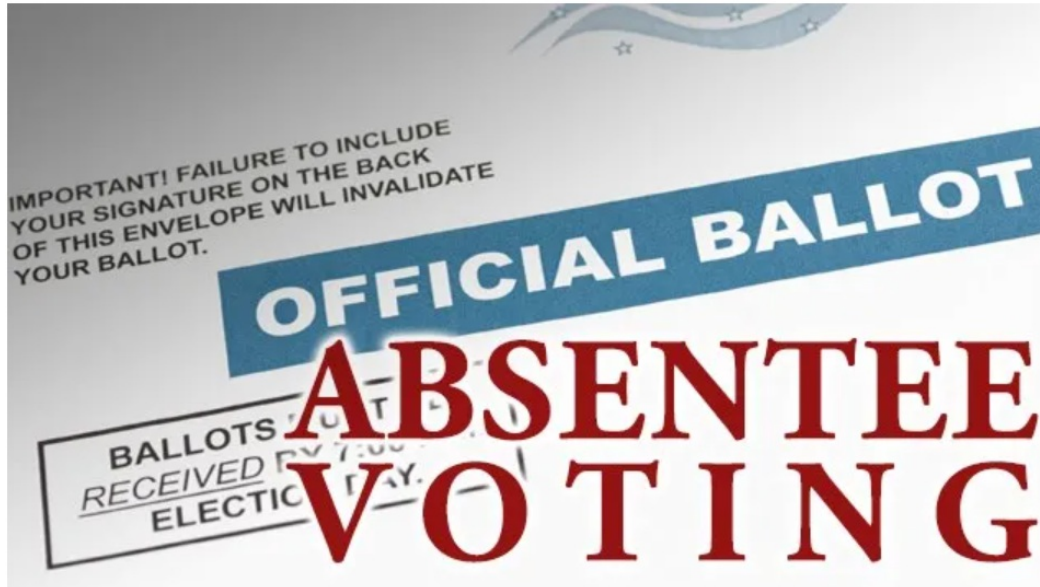

Rejoice, Democracy-Builders! The Ohio Controlling Board authorized the Ohio Secretary of State's office to send absentee (vote-by-mail/vote-by-home) REQUEST form.

As of now, all **7.8 million registered voters** thus far will receive a request form beginning around Labor Day, September 7th, 2020. Please encourage your family, friends, colleagues, and community to check check their voter registration status to receive a absentee (vote-by-mail) request form.

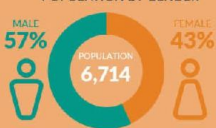
